Thank you for the email. I just tried to call you, but you did not pick up, and your voice mail is full.

Since you have not mentioned them in your complaint, I can only assume that you have overlooked the fact that the FEC previously sent a Request for Additional Information ("RFAI") to the campaign on this, and that about ten days before you filed your complaint the campaign filed an amended July quarterly report and a response to the RFAI that confirmed that virtually all of the loan came from the candidate's personal funds. The amount that came from the candidate's spouse was within the contribution limit. Those filings, which have been available on the FEC's website since October 1st, are attached for your reference. I assume that you would have mentioned them in the complaint if you were aware of them.

I trust that this fully resolves your concerns, and would hope that you would accordingly withdraw the complaint. If not, please note that we fully reserve all rights and remedies in connection with this matter. Please note that you are now on notice that any allegation that the campaign accepted a \$100,000 loan from the candidate's husband is false.
